Welsh Government aim to roll this out to all 2 year old children across Wales. We will shortly be writing out to families living in the new areas to invite them to apply. Torfaen are also hosting events this week at existing Flying Start childcare settings for settings to visit and discuss Flying Start openly with settings already benefiting from offering Flying Start.
